Prayer Guidance

The ministry of Prayer Guidance allows one pilgrim on the journey of life to accompany another. In fidelity to Ignatian Spirituality, Thornhill Ministries trains and gives on-going support to those involved in the ministry of spiritual accompaniment.



Adult Faith Development

In the support of faith development, we provide individuals, parishes and other groups with reflection days, short courses, non-residential retreats and fora for discussion of contemporary Church matters.



Meditation

Meditation and contemplation are core components of true prayer. Thornhill Ministries provides distinctive programmes that assist growth in meditation. 'Moments of Meditation' is a series of evenings that, through the use of poetry, art and classical music, leads into the quiet stillness within.



Literature & Spirituality

Works of various literary genres speak of the spiritual in creative images and language. Those with a keen interest in literature and spirituality are given a pathway for accessing The Divine through our short courses.



Liturgical Training

There are many people directly involved in Liturgical Ministry. The sacred work of proclaiming God's Word, of distributing Holy Communion, of preparing the décor and of caring for the church building are aspects of ministry for which we provide on-going support and training.



Church Music

We visit Church choirs in their parishes, on request, to offer guidance and support. Church music seminars assist in responding to more general needs, in the provision of new sacred music and technical support in conducting, sight singing and other appropriate disciplines.



School Retreats

A team based at Thornhill Ministries offers retreats to second-level students. Structured reflection, meditation and 'fun with a purpose' activities offer opportunities for creativity, imagination and prayer.



Interfaith Dialogue

Thornhill Ministries continues to explore avenues of interaction among Christian people. We are committed to developing links and shared understanding while accepting the diversity of traditions in relation to spirituality, worship and theology.
